GPF Lewis plc and their subsidiary company GPF Lewis Solutions Ltd will fully comply with the duties placed upon them within the requirements of Statutory Legislation, whilst at all times complying with, as a matter of best practice, the requirements and duties set out within Approved Codes of Practice and Guidance as issued by the Health and Safety Executive, and the Construction (Design & Management) Regulations 2015.

All employees and Subcontractors are expected to co-operate and assist in the implementation of this policy, whilst ensuring that their own works, so far as is reasonably practicable, are carried out without risk to themselves, others or the environment. This includes co-operating with management on any health, safety or environment related matter.

GPF Lewis plc and their subsidiary company GPF Lewis Solutions Ltd will take all practical steps to ensure that potential hazards and risks are identified, and that suitable and effective preventative and control measures are implemented. All employees will be provided with the necessary instruction and training in safe methods of work, the efficient operation and maintenance of tools and equipment, and the correct safety equipment and personal protective equipment. Furthermore, the necessary financial resources will be made available by the company in order for GPF Lewis plc and their subsidiary company GPF Lewis Solutions Ltd to comply with its statutory duties and requirements of this policy.

The Managing Director has overall responsibility for all Health, Safety, Welfare and Environmental matters. This policy will be reviewed and revised by the Health, Safety and Compliance Director, as required to reflect changes within the Company, technical advances and legislative developments. The operation of this policy and the associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed by the Board of Directors on a regular basis to ensure that they remain current and applicable to the company's activities.
